	<ol> <li>Degrease all surfaces to be stripped using TegraShield WDA800 Wash Down Agent. Abrade glossy surfaces.</li> </ol>
	<ol> <li>To clean dry surfaces brush apply 1 full coat of TegraStrip WBA50 at a coverage rate of 1-4 m<sup>2</sup>/litre. Apply flame retardant plastic sheeting directly onto stripper forcing out any air bubbles. Ensure all joints and seams are adequately taped.</li> </ol>
	3. After 24 hours remove a piece of sheeting and test scrape a small area. If paint is sufficiently softened, scrape off using heavy duty steel scrapers. If paint is still firm near substrate replace plastic sheeting and allow more contact time for the stripper to penetrate before scraping paint off.
	<ol> <li>Very thick paint layers or highly absorbent surfaces may need steps 2 and 3 to be repeated until a satisfactory outcome is achieved.</li> </ol>
	5. To any remaining ingrained paint residues apply a thin coat of TegraStrip WBA50 and allow to dwell for 1 hour. Using heavy duty metal scouring pads thoroughly scour and remove all residue.
	6. Wash down all stripped surfaces with clean water.
